STUDENT POLICY

Location:

All lessons take place at The Music School at Sound Crossing (MSSC) which is located in Poquonock Community Church, 1817 Poquonock Ave. Windsor, CT 06095

Lesson attendance:

Lesson attendance is key to a student's musical development and success. Students are expected to attend lessons on a weekly basis. A 24-hour advance notice with a valid reason such as illness, family emergency or religious holiday must be communicated directly to Sound Crossing or to your teacher in order to receive a make-up for a private lesson. Refunds will not be issued for student absences. Students will be offered a make-up lesson for any lesson missed due to teacher absence.

Lesson make-up policy:

- Students may receive 1 make-up lessons per year.
- Students/parents must give 24-hour notice for all non-emergency absences in order to receive a make-up for that absence.
- Make-up lessons will be given at the discretion of the individual instructor

Student expectations

Lesson attendance makes up only one part of a student's musical training. Students are expected to practice regularly between lesson days. Practice provides opportunity for students to apply the skills and techniques covered during lessons

Student performance

Students will be given the opportunity to perform in concerts and recitals throughout the year. Performance gives purpose to musical study. Students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of performance opportunities and are expected to participate in at least one recital or community outreach concert during the school-year.

Payment policy

- Lesson fees are due according to the payment schedule above
- Monthly installment fees are due at the first lesson of each month (Sep through May).
- A \$10 late fee will be assessed for all past due fees and students with past due balances will be ineligible for sibling discounts.

Student Withdrawal

All requests for withdrawal must be submitted in writing to the director and made by the parent, guardian, or adult student. Absence and/or verbal notice are not sufficient for withdrawal notification. Withdrawal notification must include

- Name of the student
- Reason for withdrawal
- Name of the parent, guardian, or adult student who is requesting the withdrawal on the student's behalf
- Date of withdrawal

Pleaes note that a submitted registration form constitutes agreement to pay tuition in full (regardless of how much has actually been paid).
